>> It is up to God's people who is willing to lay down the flesh, understand God's nature and perspective, raise them up, as a banner, as our standard, without compromise, we may than enter the battle field, gaining the right to deliver the message, to bring the voice from the heaven, to express compassion, love, and power of forgiveness, for God's Hand to be able to work in His way.

>> God is working through us to fight the battles, but only when His people are coming under His own standard, standing on His side, He may then pick up the instrument or the weapons (us) to make the move with a change in the nations.
